

CONSULTATION ON SCHOOL ADMISSION ARRANGEMENTS FOR 2019-2020

Kingston Council is consulting on proposed admission arrangements for community schools, In-year admissions and the coordinated primary and secondary admissions schemes for 2019-2020.

There are two proposed changes for 2019-2020:

- 1) to include priority for children of staff as an admissions criterion for 2019/2020;
- 2) to remove the separate admissions criteria for entry into Reception and transfer into Year 3 for Alexandra School. These were in place during the transition period from infant to junior for Alexandra School (formerly an infant school) and St Paul's CofE Primary School, Kingston Hill (formerly a junior school).

There are no other proposed changes to the admission arrangements for community schools and the only significant change to the coordinated primary and secondary schemes from 2018-19 is to the dates in the Pan London timetable.
