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SATs Revision Support

Dear Parents and Carers,

Please find attached to this letter a booklet to help support your child in the build up to SATs. We are doing everything we can at school to prepare your child for the tests; we know many of you are also working very hard at home to do the same. To aid this process, we have prepared example question papers and spelling lists which you may find beneficial. We suggest you use the booklet to help your child become more confident with the content and style of SATs papers; to inform you of any gaps in their knowledge and to increase their speed and stamina in test situations. We do not expect these papers back and teachers will not be marking them. Instead, if needed, you may find the answers on the school website in the Parents' section, under SATs. Here you will also find links to some other useful SATs information and lots more maths revision activities.

How to use this booklet:

The booklet is in 5 parts:

- Maths – arithmetic questions
- Maths – reasoning questions
- Grammar and punctuation questions
- Two Reading comprehensions
- Spelling lists.

To be really effective, please use these resources in conjunction with the comments from reports – focusing first on targets and next steps which teachers have set. The questions in these papers are examples; after they have been attempted, we encourage you to change words or numbers in them to create similar problems for your child to solve. We highly recommend that you discuss the reading comprehensions with your child once they have completed the questions. This will provide an opportunity to check on general misconceptions, unfamiliar vocabulary and deeper, inferred meanings – not just literal understanding of the words. The spelling lists have also been provided to make you aware of the expectations for the spelling test and for pupils' writing.
