

Thank you for volunteering to be your child's class' parent rep. It is a role in which you can make a real contribution to our school and help to create a greater sense of community across the school. Parent reps have two main roles:

- To liaise between parents and staff, sharing suggestions and queries.
- To co-ordinate activities for the parents of your child's class, whether social or fundraising.

Parent reps traditionally do the following:

- Attend Class Rep meetings with Mr Williams, collating any comments or queries in advance, and making sure that they are positively worded and appropriate.
- Create a class' 'Whatsapp' group to communicate with parents about up and coming events.
- Challenge any negative comments about the school made on social media, and alert the school to this immediately.
- Organise for at least one parent (or rep) from each year group, if not you, to come to PTA meetings.
- Help to organise your year group cake sales with the parent reps in the parallel classes (sending out a letter/ message to parents requesting cakes).
- Help organise your class stall at the Christmas and Summer Fair most importantly ensuring you have a rota of parents to help.
- Coordinate a gift and card from parents at Christmas and at the end of the school year, for the teacher and classroom assistant (this is desirable but not essential!).
- Arrange occasional social activities for parents in your class to build friendships between parents and to make the organisation of class activities easier.
