Voluntary Contribution

At Burlington Junior school, we provide children with an enriched education and school experience, and we enhance their learning through workshops, events, and outdoor learning spaces. In order for us to be able to provide this, each year we ask parents/carers to make a voluntary contribution.

The voluntary contribution for Burlington Junior School is £100 per family, although you are welcome to give more, of course. We completely understand that many families are facing difficult financial circumstances and we are therefore asking for contributions only if you feel you are able to.

The contributions are entirely voluntary and we are incredibly grateful for any support you are able to give.

You make your donation via your School Gateway account either through a one-off payment of £100 or in smaller instalments throughout the year. Please note that School Gateway will show a balance against each child you have at the school so you only need to make the payments against one child.

If you need any assistance with School Gateway or are having problems activating your account, please speak to the school office.

In addition, UK taxpayers can Gift Aid their donations e.g. for every £100 paid with gift aid the school will receive an additional £25 from the UK government. Please read the declaration at the checkout and enter your

full name and address in the payments comments box when paying via School Gateway. This means the school will receive an additional 25% on each contribution. If you are NOT a UK taxpayer, please state this in the comments box so that we do not claim Gift Aid on your donation.
