

2025 Burlington Junior School SATs results.

- Children in Y6 complete SATs tests in reading, SPAG (spelling punctuation and grammar) and maths. The writing in Y6 is assessed by the teachers over a number of months. This allows children to show their best writing across a range of pieces, rather than one piece.
- During SATs week, tests generally take place according to the schedule below. Writing is moderated by staff and the local authority and the data is sent to the government Standards and Testing Agency in the week of 23rd June.
