What to bring



You must bring:

- Any medication you need, labelled with your name and instructions. You will need to have filled in the consent form on Google forms.
- Pyjamas.
- Underwear.
- Sanitary products.
- Socks - for many activities, socks will need to cover your ankles.
- Two pairs of trousers/leggings or long shorts for activities (preferably not jeans as they can get very heavy when wet).
- 1 pair of trainers for activities.
- 1 pair of spare shoes (preferably old trainers) for wet activities.
- Fleeces/sweatshirts for activities.
- Long sleeved shirt/t-shirts (for activities where arms need to be covered).
- Waterproof coat
- Sun hat.
- Sun cream.
- 1 or 2 sets of clothes for the evening.
- Towel for showering.
- Water bottle.
- Small rucksack/bag.
- Labelled carrier bags for wet and dirty clothing.
- Wash bag (including soap/shower gel, shampoo, toothpaste and toothbrush).
- Reading book.
- Lip balm / lip salve.

If you want, you can bring:

- Pair of shoes for evening activities.
- Card games e.g. Top Trumps.
- Old towel for wet activities.
- Teddy bear – not too big, not too small!
- Waterproof trousers.
- Maximum of £10 pocket money, in change. This should be placed in the named moneybag that will be given out before the trip.
- Watch.
- A stamped addressed postcard so you can write home.

You can't bring a mobile phone or any other electronic equipment that wouldn't be allowed in class.

Children should not bring Fitbits as they are likely to get wet, damaged or lost.
